100 Club Objectives and Rules

The purpose of the 100 Club is to ensure that Speedway continues at Arlington Stadium and to provide funds for improvements to the club. The senior officers of the 100 Club are Trevor Geer and Mike Bellerby. They will take responsibility for investing the profits in the very best interest of the Eastbourne Speedway Club – e.g. purchase of riders, assisting with rider's costs (such as airfares, accommodation, equipment, vehicles as required), and safety improvements.

Membership Rules

- a) The maximum number of members is 100
- b) The cost of membership is £1000 per annum which will entitle the member to entry into 20 draws at £50 per draw entry. To take part in all the draws an application form and full remittance must be submitted by 20th March 2012.
- c) The 100 Club will retain 60% of the total income and the remaining 40% will be paid out in prize money. The prize fund being split into 20 draws.
- d) The draws will take place at the first 20 speedway meetings of the 2012 season
- e) The maximum prize fund for each draw will be £2000 (based on the Eagles 100 Club being fully subscribed), and the prize values as follows:

1 st prize	£1000
2 nd prize	£700
3 rd prize	£300

If the Eagles 100 Club is not fully subscribed, the prize fund for each draw will be split into three prizes as follows one of 50% (first prize), one of 35% (second prize) and one of 15% (third prize)
- f) Membership can be given to an individual, a business or a group of supporters. If not held by an individual, membership by a business or group of supporters must have one appointed representative
- g) Draw numbers will be issued on a first come, first served basis and will only be available from the promoter of the lottery
- h) Applicants must be over 16 years of age to participate
- i) A list of all members and their numbers will be published in the Eastbourne Speedway meeting programme
- j) Winners will be notified as soon as practicable after each draw has taken place and results will be published in the Eastbourne Speedway meeting programme
- k) All prize money will be paid out by cheque
- l) In a dispute, the decision of the promoter of the lottery is final
